## Policy changes for 60-day dispensing

Last week the Australian Government confirmed a 60-day supply for prescription medication, rather than the current 30-day supply, will be made available from September 1.

Once this policy is implemented, doctors will be able to make a clinical decision about whether 30-day or 60-day prescribing is appropriate for the individual circumstances of their patients.

It is anticipated at least 6 million Australians will halve their medicine costs and need fewer visits to the GP and pharmacist, saving patients more than \$1.6 billion over the next four years.

"Every year nearly a million Australians are forced to delay or go without a medicine that their doctor has told them is necessary for their health," said Australian Minister for Health and Aged Care Mark Butler.

"This cheaper medicines policy is safe, good for Australians' hip pockets and most importantly, good for their health.

"Australian pharmacies already do much more than just dispense medicine and the Government is supporting our trusted pharmacists to play an even bigger role in the healthcare

of Australians." Some pharmacists are concerned this policy may have unintended consequences.

Owner of Priceline Pharmacy Kingston in Channel Court Matthew Pilkington considered some of the risks this policy could pose.

"Pharmacists across the country may be forced to charge for things that have previously been free, including health advice," said Mr Pilkington.

"60-day dispensing will be changing the role of the community pharmacist as we know it.

"I am worried this may result in a fee for service in pharmacies and further widen the gap between those who can and those who cannot afford it, it would be terrible."

Mr Pilkington said aged care facilities and residents in the Kingborough and Huon region will likely face substantially higher costs for medication packaging and services, or possibly find pharmacies are unable to service these facilities.

The Australian Government has stated they are investing \$350 million to community pharmacy outreach into aged care facilities.

## Waiting for shelter

Kingborough's Roz Thurn reached out to Minister for Infrastructure and Transport Michael Ferguson asking whether a bus shelter for Margate was planned in the near future.

Minister Ferguson confirmed a bus shelter will be constructed as part of the Hobart City Deal, although he was unable to advise when these works would be delivered.

The *Kingborough Chronicle* reached out to Kingborough Mayor Paula Wriedt.

"I'm looking forward to the Department of State Growth rolling out their DDA compliant bus shelter program," said Cr Wriedt.

"Residents have been waiting a long time for this."

It is anticipated works will commence later this year.

Nothing's been done about the traffic congestion in Margate either.





# New Snug Village facilities opened

A new 14 bed wing together with a day centre was officially opened at Snug Village by the Hon Julie Collins MP and Mark Hochman Chair of Christian Homes Tasmania (CHT).

"The \$5.4m development adds to the substantial footprint CHT has at its Snug site which includes the existing residential care facility and independent living units," CHT Chair Mark Hochman said at the opening.

"The project was undertaken by local builder Maveric Builders.

"Established 50 years ago, CHT has sought to faithfully care and provide for the aged sector of our community based on Christian values.

"Snug as a potential site was first pursued in 1995

with an initial opening twenty years ago with five residents.

"Since that time, we have been blessed by the support CHT has received from government and the community which has seen the Snug complex grow to a 76 bed facility today providing quality services and care for our aged community members.

"CHT was honoured to have our local federal member Hon Julie Collins officiate at the opening."

Among those present at the opening were Kingborough Deputy Mayor Clare Glade-Wright and Members for Franklin Dean Young, Dean Winter and Rosalie Woodruff.

CHT operates another residential aged care facility, Hawthorn Village, in Blackmans Bay and numerous independent living unit sites across the Kingborough municipality and Roches Beach on the Eastern Shore.



# Raise a cup for a cancer-free future

Around 10 Tasmanians are diagnosed with cancer every day and despite millions of dollars in research funding-almost \$20 million last year alone-that figure is expected to rise to 15 by the year 2040.

The goal of Cancer Council Tasmania (CCT) and its affiliated bodies in other states is a cancer-free future, and that's where a cup of tea and a chat at a social gathering can help.

For years the South Channel Residents and Ratepayers Association has hosted a Biggest Morning Tea event raising an estimated \$1000 each time - money desperately needed in the fight against cancer.

The next morning tea will be held at 10am on Saturday, May 13 at Middleton Hall where CCT CEO Penny Egan will outline the work undertaken by the organisation.

CCT is a charity working to minimise the incidence and impact of cancer on Tasmanians through advocacy, raising awareness of cancer prevention and offering support and information for those affected.

But, as Penny Egan will note in her address, this wide-ranging programme could not be achieved without the generosity of Tasmanians at events like The Biggest Morning Tea and a team of volunteers.

One of the key components of CCT's work is running a regular series of support groups covering different cancers and these have proved invaluable particularly for those people, including a rising number from the Channel, who have been newly diagnosed and are looking for advice and support from those further along in their treatment.

# New detection cameras

**Click, Store, Go is the latest campaign from the Tasmanian Government and the Road Safety Advisory Council (RSAC).**

RSAC Chair Scott Tilyard said Click, Store, Go is a reminder to Tasmanian motorists to always click on your seatbelt, store your phone and you're good to go.

"Using mobile phones means drivers have their eyes off the road, their hands off the steering wheel, and their minds off the road and the surrounding situation," said Mr Tilyard.

"Evidence shows distraction caused by mobile phones can impair performance in a number of ways, notably braking reaction time, but also reaction to traffic signals, ability to keep in the correct lane, shorter following distances, and an overall reduction in awareness of what is happening around you.

"We want drivers to reduce their distractions when they're driving and if you don't feel like you have the willpower to stop looking at your phone, you should turn it off and put it away.

"Unlike distraction, incorrectly wearing a seatbelt is not necessarily the cause of crashes, but it does

increase the severity of the injury.

"Although it's hard to believe there are some people who still choose not to wear a seatbelt, this simple action can reduce the risk of being killed in a crash by up to 50 per cent.

"So please, always wear your seatbelt correctly and make sure your passengers do too," Mr Tilyard said.

New detection cameras that detect people not wearing a seatbelt correctly or illegally using a mobile phone have recently commenced on-road testing.

"These new cameras will be mobile and operate all around Tasmania, both day and night," said Minister for Infrastructure and Transport Michael Ferguson.

"Once on-road testing is completed, drivers detected not wearing a seatbelt or illegally using a mobile phone will receive a fine of \$362 and three demerit points.

"Automated speed detection cameras have been in force in Tasmania since September last year, already nabbing 18,437 speedsters.

"Now, we are ramping up this technology to make our roads safer."

## An open letter to Treasurer Jim Chalmers regarding the Budget

Dear Dr Chalmers,

There's a crisis in our country you can fix in your first budget, at no extra cost.

With the stroke of a pen you could help secure the future of critical regional news services, using money already allocated in the budget.

All you need to do is allocate a fairer percentage of the federal government's advertising budget to local and regional news services, rather than spending almost all of it with corporate capital city media and foreign-owned digital platforms (which don't produce any content or employ any journalists).

This can be achieved by simply adopting the Victorian Govt policy that mandates a weekly full page government advertisement in every regional and community paper.

Local and regional newspapers connect more than 80% of the country, but they get almost 0% of the government advertising spend.

In an era where false news spreads faster on social media than the truth does, trusted local news services reach more regional Australians than any other medium.

And unlike other media, every government dollar spent with a local newspaper is also an investment in regional journalism jobs.

This shouldn't be controversial.

A recent parliamentary inquiry recommended that a minimum of 20% of government print advertising should be placed with regional news services. A recent study conducted by Deakin University recommended the same thing. In fact, the Minister for Communications, Michelle Rowland, has been advocating for more regional newspaper advertising for many years.

We know there may be bigger budget issues, but this small policy change would be a simple and fair solution to a growing problem for regional Australia.

A policy that ensures weekly federal government advertising is placed in regional newspapers would be great news for the country.

And it won't cost you a cent.
