"Minority government is destabilising, it destroys confidence and is bad for our state and for Tasmanians."

Whilst the Tasmanian Electoral Commission's (TEC) count continues at the time of print, results indicate the Liberal Party will win the most seats, although not enough to secure a majority government.

The party has fallen from favour with a 12 per cent swing against Liberals.

Eric Abetz and Jacquie Petrusma have been voted in for the Liberal Party in the Franklin electorate, with Housing Minister Nic Street likely to join them.


Greens Rosalie Woodruff easily won her seat with 8965 first preference votes registered.

Dean Winter has been re-elected from the Labor Party with 7500 first preference votes.

David O'Byrne has successfully won a seat as an independent after quitting the Labor Party.

Results remain provisional, with the TEC expecting final results to be declared on Wednesday, April 10.

DAPs bypass local councils

Dear Editor

Whilst it was both enlightening and depressing to read some of the answers given to questions posed to Franklin electoral candidates by the Kingborough Chronicle on Tuesday, March 12, it's a pity they were not asked their views on Development Assessment Panels (DAPs).

This is a Liberal Government proposal to remove any rights for councils or the public to object to or appeal against any development proposals in National Parks, the Tasmanian Wilderness World Heritage Area, (TWWHA), and even on private land.

The Minister for Planning of the day will be given the power to take away assessment and approval decisions of developments from the normal local council processes and place them in the hands of DAPs.

This would allow property developers to bypass local councils and communities and remove elected councillors from having any say on the most controversial and destructive developments affecting local communities

Once a proposal is placed before a DAP there will be no right for the community to object to or appeal any final decision to the Planning Tribunal.

The opportunity to lodge a merit-based appeal to the Tasmanian Civil and Administrative Tribunal, (TCAT), will be removed.

ing its financial plan and forecasts to ensure the organisation is on a solid financial footing moving forward." The council's draft budget will be open for community

consultation from April 3 until Wednesday, May 1.

Two youths charged over alleged crime spree

Two male youths from southern Tasmania, aged 14 and 16, have been charged in relation to an alleged crime spree totalling \$120,000 after an extensive investigation by Kingston Criminal Investigation Branch.

The charges relate to burglary, stealing, unlawfully setting fire to property and dangerous driving offences committed in the greater Hobart area in between February 17 and March 15, including the theft of cars which were subsequently destroyed by fire on the Eastern Shore.

Total value of property destroyed is estimated at

\$120,000

The 14-year-old youth was charged with three counts of dangerous driving, three counts of aggravated burglary of a dwelling, two counts of burglary, six counts of motor vehicle stealing, six counts of stealing and five counts of unlawful setting fire to property.

The 16-year-old youth was charged with three counts of aggravated burglary of a dwelling, two counts of burglary, five counts of unlawful setting fire to property and five counts of motor vehicle stealing.

The youths will appear in the Hobart Youth Justice Court at a later date.
